**Technical Committee report:**

**Winter Classic:**

First weekend went very well. We had some college coaches out and our players got some good looks. Far West Regional League was very impressed with our event and are going to plan for more teams from out of state to come to our future Winter Classic Tournaments. This weekend we have the U11's – U13's. Schedules changed yesterday so please check your schedule for any changes.

If you have a guest player from outside of the club you will need to bring the player card with a signed roster listing this guest player. In order to obtain a signed roster, you need to contact the club registrar, Andree' Ament. Andree' will need a copy of the current player card. If that isn't available, she will need a copy of the guest player's birth certificate or passport, and the guest player will need to fill out a form and pay \$20 for registration to ensure insurance coverage. If you do not have a guest player from outside of the club you do not need to come in to register your team, this has been taken care of for you. However, you will need to come by and get your Winter Classic pins for your team.

**New trainer for U8, U9 and U12:**

We are bringing on Eugene Poublon as the trainer for all U8-U9 and U12 players. Individual technical training/ball mastery is incredibly important through U12. We have brought in Eugene to work with Viet to provide the highest level of technical training our U8-U12 age groups.

**Marketing:**

**Red List:**

The red list is very long this month. The board has decided to collect cards from those teams that are starting state cup this weekend as all contracts require payment in full prior to the start of state cup. If a player needs their card this weekend they can come pay their balance to a board member in the clubhouse between 6:00 and 8:00pm this Friday night (1/10/14). If they pay online they will need to bring their receipt of payment to the clubhouse Friday in order to get their player card back.

**Registrar:**

For state cup, once the roster freezes there is nothing we can do to change a roster. You must get all your roster changes in prior to the roster freeze date. The roster freeze date is generally 5 days prior to the first pool game. However if there is an issue with adding a player to your roster it may take time to get a player added. Please contact Andree' Ament at [registrar@pacnwsc.org](mailto:registrar@pacnwsc.org) as soon as you know you will be making a roster change. If the change involves moving a player from one team to another (for example Blue team to Maroon team), you must turn in the old card before a new card will be issued.

Andree will be registering all the teams for state cup as directed by Leighton, Viet and Malia. Will all U10 teams be doing state cup? Yes.

**Surveys:**
