 - a. At PacNW we strive to achieve a balance between the technical team and the board.

- 4. "State of the Club" Update/Year in Review John Wilson, President
 - a. In 2017-18 we had 4 State Cup Champions and 4 President's Cup Champions
 - b. We currently have 2 teams playing in Presidents Cup in Salt Lake City

- c. Hired a new boys DOC Pedro Milan
- d. Made new coaching additions, include several PacNW Alums Kailiana Johnson, Vincent Nguyen, Hamidou Kante, Aimee Inthoulay
- e. A record number of teams attended Winter Classic (494 teams from 6 states and 2 Canadian Provinces)
- f. Several PacNW players received National Team Call-Ups
- g. Hired M'ily Reiter as Club Administrator. She will be supporting the directors in admin functions and doing graphic design for the club, in addition to coaching teams.
- h. Formed a new partnership with OSA for men's and women's teams. A number of coaches and alums are playing on the teams and Malia Arrant and Pedro Milan are the head coaches for the women's and men's teams.
- i. Launched a new PacNW website. We are still working to fine tune it, but the main body of work is complete
- j. Added TeamSnap club wide in order to improve communication amongst team members and to distribute information to the team managers. We are using it for club wide communication at this time.
- k. PacNW was accepted into the ECNL, offering a better pool of play for our top tear girls' teams at ages U13, U14, U15, U16, U17, and U18/19. We are one of four teams in Washington in the ECNL
- I. We continue to grow as a club:
 - 1. 2015-16 784 registered players
 - 2. 2016-17 828 registered players
 - 3. 2017-18 928 registered players
 - 4. 2018-19 987 registered players
 *These numbers do not include Junior Program Players
- m. Social Media Growth We are an effective presence on Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter. Growth on Facebook has slowed, likely due to saturation. We continue to grow on Instagram and Twitter.
- n. Finances
- 1. Operating Income in 2018 was approximately \$2,400,000. We are currently operating at a slight deficit
- 2. The Foundation account is healthy and is used for special projects and financial aid.
- How are we using our money? Approximately 50% of our income is used for coach salaries. Field rental expenses claim another large portion.
- o. Looking Forward to 2018-19
 - i. PacNW will be participating in its 1st year of ECNL competition.
 - ii. We are looking for closer collaboration and integration with our association partners including KCYSA and GRTJSA
 - iii. We are still looking for additional club partners, including a jersey sponsor.
 - 1. The expense of a logo on each jersey is approximately \$20-25,000.
 - 2. We are asking for around \$40,000/year so that we can also fund our financial aid
