1. Welcome and Introduction - John Wilson
  - a. We're starting to finish up the season
2. Registrar's Report - Robin Hautamaki
  - a. Thank you for your patience while our club and board migrated to a new email system. We are done now.
  - b. U9-14 State Cup. Robin will be moving players this Sunday to the rosters they will be playing on during state cup.   - b. We are having a lot of issues when teams are trying to collect money via Paypal and Venmo because there is no transparency with these accounts. Chase has Zell – we would prefer you use this method because the money goes straight into the team account, with a name attached to it.
  - c. We need to collect ALL receipts from 2018 from all teams.

- a. We have 2 associations we have been affiliated with: 1) GRTJSA and 2) KCYSA. In January we learned that KCYSA wanted to disassociate with PacNW and join up with Maple Valley. Kent United and Maple Valley Premier are no longer. They are forming a new club called VALOR. In reality, this will not affect the way we are doing things as players can really play anywhere they would like. VALOR will play in the RCL on provisional status.
