2. Q&A with Technical Director – Leighton O.
  - a. **Goal Keeper Coach Update:** We are looking at four different goal keeper coaches. They have been running the keeper sessions and being evaluated. Two of these coaches have already been here, and the remaining two will be running the sessions in the weeks to come. We are hoping to have a decision by Nov.
    - i. The goal keeper training schedule can be found on the website.
  - b. **Friday Night Finishing** is coming up (10/12 through 11/5). A director will always be there with other coaches as assistants. There will be lots of repetition. The keepers are admitted free as long as they play as goal keepers. Managers get 50% off. This is open to PacNW and non-RCL players.
  - c. ECNL – We had our 1<sup>st</sup> tournament at Davis. Everything on the field went well.
  - d. Fall Festival – November 17 & 18. This is for 2011 and 2010 teams.
    - i. Each team will get a minimum for 3 games.
    - ii. Teams do not need to be “premier” level clubs – teams will be appropriately seeded. Teams playing in the RCL will not participate. We will need referees – you do not need the gear or license to referee at this event. It will pay \$15/hour toward your account. Just wear all black PacNW gear. 2006 and older.
  - e. Winter Classic is right around the corner. Managers DO NOT sign up your teams, your teams will be automatically entered. Please double check which weekend your team is playing and please share with your parents. This information can be found on the website under the Winter classic.

5. Registrar's Report – Robin Hautamaki, Registrar
- a. A SafeSport email went out Sunday morning. There is a total of 4 modules/certificates with the training. It will take about 90 minutes to complete. All managers need to complete this. Please send Robin the last certificate to show that you have completed it. It will be good for 2 years.
6. Treasurer's Report
- a. Treasurers should have received an email regarding the treasurer's report. This needs to be turned into Michelle P at 2 separate times, 1) end of calendar year, 2) end of season.
  - b. Volunteer Tracking for your team – Jeff Hemmen
    - i. As described in the club handbook, this job falls to the team treasurer. If your team does not have a treasurer, it falls to team manager.
    - ii. Nancy, our Volunteer Coordinator, – will work with team treasurers to track each team's volunteer hours.
    - iii. All club families are responsible for completing 10 hours of volunteer time per family, NOT per player. Some families bought out for \$150 at TCB, in the beginning of the year, so they do not need to complete these hours. Managers and treasurers do not need to complete further volunteer time, it is presumed with the manager and treasurer role.
    - iv. Nancy will email out a Smartsheet with live stats emailed out to treasurers.
    - v. High school boys will be invoiced (\$175) in Mid Nov. if they have not paid or completed their hours. All others will be invoiced in Mid-January for any uncompleted hours. Fall Festival will be the last opportunity for high school boys. Winter Classic will be the last opportunity for all others. U9 has no volunteer requirement.
    - vi. Club Volunteer vs. Team Chores:
      - 1. The handbook describes which jobs receive 10 hours credit and which jobs are just part of being part of the team.
    - vii. Managers and treasurers please help us communicate with your teams. – Treasurers will need to keep an eye on the volunteer hours via SmartSheet and encourage those needing hours to volunteer. Treasurer can act as interface between Nancy and team families.
