As a club we couldn't afford the cost of the classroom for 3 hours twice a week. The study hall will be targeted to high school students, but middle school students may be welcome as well. There may be some grade specifics mandated by the coaches in the future. Kids that need to up their academic game may be required by their coaches to attend study hall. This is still in the discussion stages.
