<u>Change to Birth Year:</u> Big news in the last month is the mandate from Washington Youth Soccer to move to birth year in 2016. Mandated smaller sided games will be coming as well but will likely start in 2017. At this time we are not sure if U12 will be 9 a side or 11 a side. This is Washington State Youth Soccer mandated so we have no control.

Leighton believes this transition will be seamless at PacNW since every team is taught the same style of play. The kids should adjust very quickly and are very adaptable.

01 boys will have tryouts before their current season is complete. Tryouts will be weekdays in late February/early March for the 01 boys. They will tryout during the week to get assigned to a team for the following May, and will then go on to play state cup to finish out the 2015-16 year with their current team.

PacNW will be holding birth year sessions during the current year and has set a goal of a birth year training session on December 28th.

<u>Change in referee association:</u> We have decided to go in a different direction with our referee association. We are moving from TRIAS to SKCSRA. This referee association is run by Richard Meeks. The process will still be the same.
