2. Director's Report: Leighton O'Brien
 - a. Friday Night Finishing Camp

YELLOW STATUS

 - Payment is due on the 15th of the month. A player is put on yellow status if they are up to 2 weeks late for a scheduled payment. Family receives notice from Affinity if there is a payment issue, and a notice from the club that the player will be moved to red list status.
 - Player is still eligible to practice and to play games
 - Players who communicate an alternate payment plan or make arrangements are often moved to yellow status even if more than 2 weeks late as long as communication and a plan is in place.

RED STATUS

 - A player is put on red list status when payment is 30 days late. The player is then removed from roster and receives an email they are ineligible to play until payment arrangements have been made.
 - Players on red status will be reviewed to come off of red status for payments made each Monday. There can't be exceptions made to the rule. PacNW does not have the infrastructure or staffing levels in place to move players last minute each week. Please help us support these time deadlines and boundaries.
